



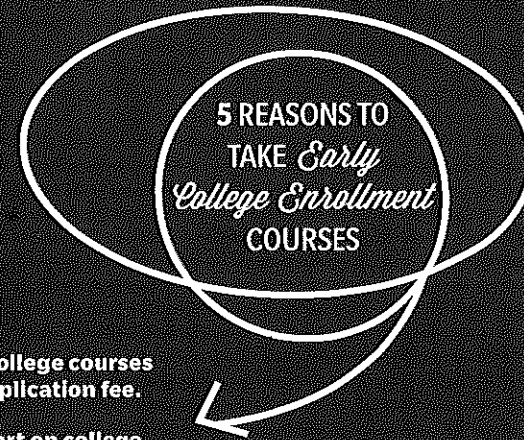
PERSONAL CONDUCT COMMITMENT

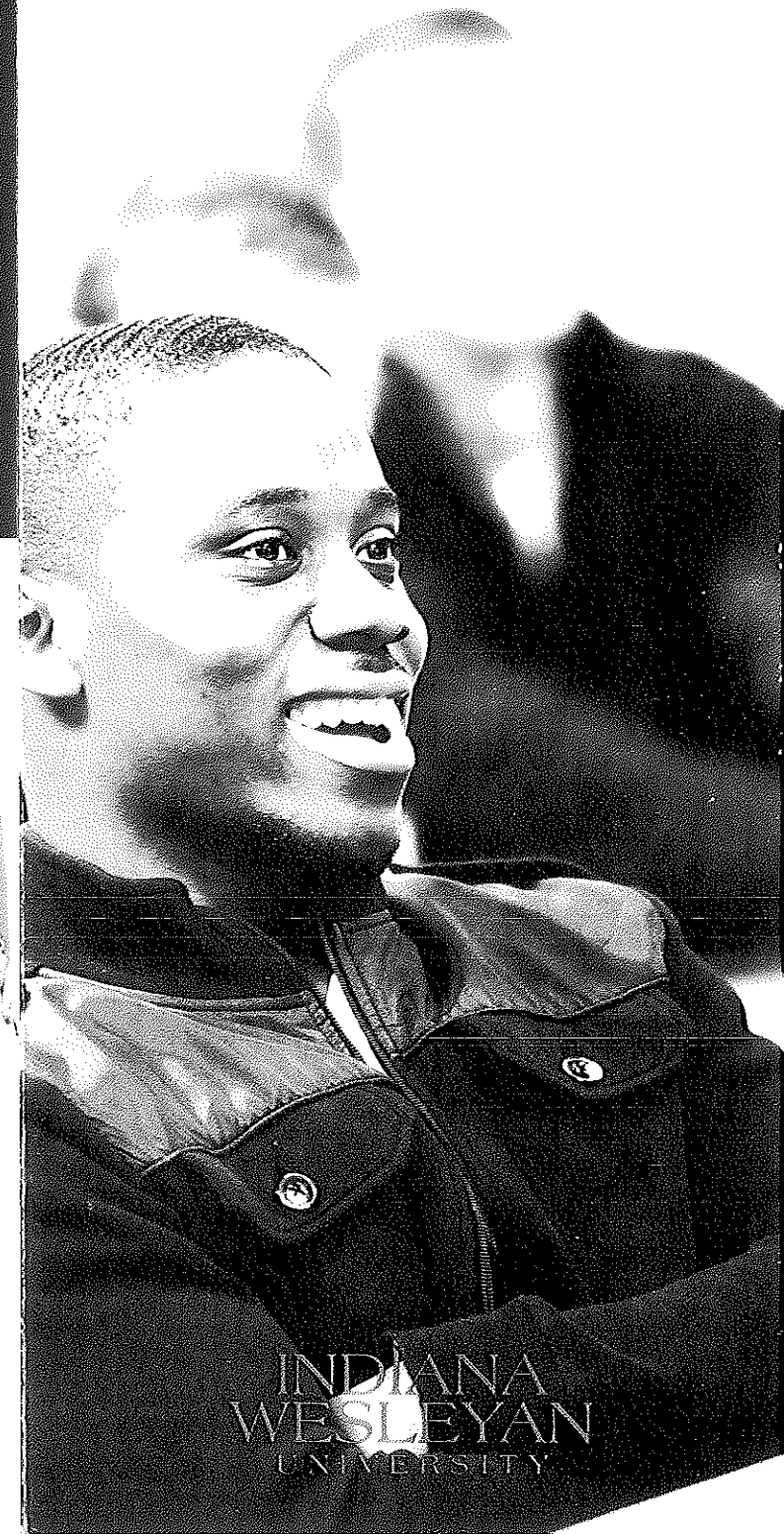

HOW IT WORKS

- Qualified high school students are offered the opportunity to enroll under the Early College Enrollment (ECE) program.
- Eligible high school students may take one course per term beginning the spring semester of their junior year, each summer session between the junior and senior years and each semester of the senior year, not to exceed four courses.
- Most freshman-level courses (100-199) are open on a space-available basis. Students must be registered by 5 pm the first day of the term.
- There is no tuition charge for credits earned under the ECE program.
- A registration fee of \$50 is charged at the time of registration for each course taken. Some courses may have an associated fee, which is also the responsibility of the applicant.
- Credits earned through the ECE program meet requirements at Indiana Wesleyan University and are transferrable.

REQUIREMENTS

- 3.0 cumulative high school GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Completed ECE application, signed by guidance counselor or principal
- Signed Personal Conduct Commitment (on the back of the application)
- Official high school transcript (first-time ECE students only)
- Recommendation from guidance counselor or principal (first-time ECE students only)
- Students must reapply for every term and submit all of the required paperwork. Students who do not make satisfactory academic progress will not be allowed to continue in the ECE program.

PROCESS

- Contact the Admissions Visit Team at 765-677-2091 at least one week in advance to schedule an appointment, which will include a meeting with an Admissions Counselor. Students registering for their first ECE course will also take a campus tour. Allow approximately 2 hours (3 for first-time ECE) to complete the process.
- Review available courses at indwes.edu/schedule and select 2 or 3 100-level courses of interest.
- Bring all required forms with you when you come for your scheduled appointment.
- Paperwork will be processed while you tour campus and/or meet with an Admissions Counselor and a Permit to Register issued.
- Visit Residential Academic Services to register for class.
- Stop by Student Account Services to pay the \$50 registration fee and any associated class fees.
- First-time ECE students can also get their IWU Student ID before leaving campus.
- Check the e-mail account you provided on your application as important information will be sent to this address regarding steps to purchase a parking permit and class announcements from your professor.
